Some Things you may want to use:

**Books**   **Stones**—you keep them lying around, right?   **Flashlight**  
**Bookshelf**   **Tall Lamp**   **PVC pipe**   **Chairs**   **Bed**   **Sleeping Bag**  
**Pillows**   **Cushions**  
**Telescopes**   **Mops**  
**Armchairs**   **Ironing Boards**   **Suitcases**  
**Tape**   **Clothes Pegs**   **Safety Pins**  
**Elastics**   **Beverages**   **Etc!**

Drape your sheet over the tallest object. Connect more sheets together as necessary, and drape over your perimeter. Use heavy things, tape, clothes pegs or safety pins to hold it together.

Water and broken glass not recommended!

Don't turn lamps on if draping over top of them!
